




Commodity by Tonnage













Fiscal Year 2014-15




Historical Cargo Throughput



Total Cargo increased by 10.6% to 1,574,903 Measurement Tons, Record Year










An Active Auto Port






Support to Oil Rigs and Squid Fishery



Economic Impact of Port of Hueneme

- 10.226 direct, induced, indirect and related jobs:
 - 2,394 direct jobs
 - **2,876 induced jobs**
 - 669 indirect jobs
 - 4,287 jobs with related port shippers/consignees
- \$799.5 million in economic activity:
 - \$303.4 million in direct business revenue
 - \$496.1 million in value of activity associated with cargo moving via the Port of Hueneme
- \$605.6 million of total personal income and consumption expenditures:
 - \$130.1 million of direct income \$54,300 average salary
 - \$312.4 million induced and consumption impact
 - \$34.5 million indirect wages
 - \$128.6 million in wages for related users
- \$67.8 million of state and local taxes:
 - \$53.4 million of direct, induced and indirect
 - \$14.4 million of related taxes
